To all Secretaries to Ministries, Chief Secretaries of Province, Heads of Departments, District Secretaries, Divisional Secretaries.

Payment of a gratuity as a merciful alternative

With reference to the special gazette notification no 2211/65 dated 22.01.2021 on the above subject.

- 02. According to the section 44 of the Minutes on Pensions amended by the aforesaid Gazette notification, public servants and daily paid employees who are not entitle for a pension but the one who deserves, may get a gratuity as a merciful alternative on their retirement. Those who are not eligible for a Widows and Orphans pension under Widows and Orphans ordinance are also entitled to receive a gratuity as a merciful alternative on behalf of deceased public servants.
- 03. However, a person who is not entitled to a pension or gratuity due to voluntary resignation, resignation or dismissal for any reason under section 20 (1) of the Minutes on Pensions, is not entitled to the above gratuity.
- 04. The gratuity as a merciful alternative should not exceed Rs. 50,000.00
- 05. Actions should be taken to recover the surcharge within the maximum of this gratuity, if there is any surcharge to the Government.
- 06. To apply a gratuity as a merciful alternative, the application form mentioned in Annexure 01 should be completed and sent to the Department of Pensions along with the following documents.
 - i. Request Letter
 - ii. Appointment Letter
- iii. Service Termination Letter
- iv. History Sheet
- v. A copy of the NIC
- vi. A certified copy of the Bank Account book
- vii. In case of Deceased officer, Death certificate / Marriage certificate / Birth certificates of children

- 07. This order shall be treated as effective from 06.01.2009.
- 08. This Circular is issued with the consent of the Secretary to the Ministry of Public Service, Provincial Councils and Local Government.
